Undergraduate Presentation Sponsored by Ivoclar Vivadent

Postgraduate Presentation

This competition is open to postgraduate students, on any research topic relevant to dentistry. The prize will be judged at the Annual Research Day Meeting where competitors will present their research as an oral presentation or a poster (at the discretion of the organising committee)

At this research meeting competitors will be preselected to go forward to present at the regional meeting in Jerusalem, where the final competition/selection for Hatton will be done, the winner will go on to compete at IADR 2017 in San Francisco. If the winner is unable to attend Jerusalem for valid visa denial reasons, video cast will be available.

Dental Health Foundation Presentation Sponsored by the Dental Health Foundation

This competition is open to all members of the dental team who are conducting research relevant to Dental Public Health and Health Promotion. The prize will be judged at the Annual Research Day Meeting where competitors will present their research as an oral presentation or a poster (at the discretion of the organising committee)

Award: Dental Health Foundation Research Prize in Primary Care Award consists of a scroll and cash prize.

Purpose: The purpose of this award is to support dental health research in Primary Care by young investigators, providing an opportunity for investigators to present their clinical studies at the Annual Research Day meeting.

Eligibility: <u>This award is open to all members of the dental team</u>. Competitors must be resident in Ireland and working on projects involving research on human subjects. Each competitor must be the sole or principal author of the work.

Postgraduate Clinical Presentation

This competition is open to postgraduate students who are conducting research relevant to clinical dentistry. The prize will be judged at the Annual Research Day Meeting where competitors will present their research as an oral presentation or a poster (at the discretion of the organising committee)

Award: The Post graduate Clinical Presentation consists of a scroll and cash prize.

Purpose: The purpose of this award is to support clinical research by young investigators, providing an opportunity for them to present their clinical studies at the Annual Research Day Meeting.

Eligibility: <u>This award is open to all clinical postgraduate students</u> <u>Competitors must be resident in Ireland and working on</u> projects involving research on human subjects. Each competitor must be the sole or principal author of the work.

Abstract Format: Enter the title (10 words or less) and support information. Name the presenter and co-author(s) Abstract text (word count 300 words) including **Objectives: Methods: Results: Conclusion:** Indicate which category you are entering Indicate if Oral or Poster presentation E-mail the completed form to: annualresearchday2016@gmail.com

The Committee of the Annual Research Day Meeting will judge the competitions. The decision of the judges will be final. The Award may be divided or withheld at the discretion of the judges. In judging, the Committee will weigh participation as follows: 50% for verbal presentation and 50% for question-and-answer period.

The following will be considered:

- 1. Originality and design of the investigation
- 2. Quality of the data produced
- 3. Suitability of the methods of analysis used 4. Scientific value of the work
- 5. Quality of the poster discussion presentation
- 6. Demonstration of mastery of the subject.
